# Level 4 – Sale of Residential Property/Residential Letting and Property Management

### **Subject Specific Units**

There is little change to the first four units of the Level 4 sales qualifications, other than the unit on building design and defects which now generally concentrates on defects rather than building construction.

### **Common Business Units**

The two common business units have seen substantial change, with various topics moving from one unit to the other and the names of the units changing. We would advise all candidates to read the existing Introduction to Office Management **and** the Advanced Office Management learning materials before attempting the examination for either of the new units.

Introduction to Office Management is now called 'Business Practice'.

Advanced Office Management is now called 'Business Management'.
