This is a brief overview of how we collect and manage your personal data, and what control you have over it.

Our commitment to you

We are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal data. This information sheet, alongside our full Privacy Notice, outlines how we do this.



What is personal data?

Personal data is any kind of information that you can be



identified by, for example, your name, date of birth, address, health records, photographs, etc.



The data we collect

We collect personal data such as your name, date of birth, education history, ethnicity, etc.

A full list of the data we collect is available in our **Privacy Notice**. We only collect the personal data that we need to deliver our services to you.

Why do we collect this data?

- To provide you with our services.
- To support you, including welfare and safeguarding.
- To comply with our legal obligations, such as health and safety, and equal opportunities monitoring.
- To provide you with information about our services.

Our lawful basis for these activities is that it is necessary for performing a task in the public interest; we have legal/contractual obligations; to look after your vital interest; we have a legitimate interest; or we have your consent.

Sharing your personal data

To provide you with our services we sometimes need to share your data with third parties, such as technology providers, awarding organisations or government bodies, for example. We will always take appropriate security

measures and never let third parties use your personal data for their own purposes. For further information, please see our full **Privacy**

How long we hold your data for?

We will only hold your personal data for as long as we need it. We are required to retain different types of data for different periods of time.
